*To prepare for next week read story from Exodus & answer these questions.
Exodus 12:*

Describe the instructions God gave Moses and Aaron in the first 4 verses.

What is significant about the instructions of the lamb from verse 5?

What do you think the areas of Egypt looked like at twilight of that day?

Why do you think God had them all kill their lambs at the same time?

Why do you believe God is so detailed in his instructions in this chapter?

God's instructions continue with blood on the doorposts and Lintel, describe what this stands for.

Why do you think God used so much symbolism of blood and death?

How would you explain this emphasis to one outside of Christ?

Describe any significance in how the lamb was to be prepared and eaten from verses 8-10.

God gets even more specific in verse 11, how do you think this practice helped them prepare for the Exodus?

Verse 12 describes what seems to be a horrible act of God, why so necessary?

How do we reconcile this act coming from a "loving God"?

Why do you think God wanted Israel to remember this occurrence? (13-27)

What are some events that help you remember what God has done for you?

What might a modern day orthodox Jewish person may be thinking as they participate in a Passover celebration?

Do you know anyone who practices this today?

We see Israel's obedience in verse 28 and we see God following through as well in verse 29. Describe Egypt's response in verses 30-33.

How did God equip his people monetarily as they left? (34-36)
